



**Registration Process**

Keystone Science School’s After School CATCH Program is available to students in grades K-5 attending Dillon Valley Elementary, Frisco Elementary, Summit Cove Elementary, Silverthorne Elementary, Breckenridge Elementary, and Upper Blue Elementary.

A registration form must be completed using the online application through Active, located at [KeystoneScienceSchool.org](http://KeystoneScienceSchool.org) Under the COMMUNITY menu click on After School CATCH. You will see a “Register Now” button for DVE, FRE, SCE, SVE students.

UBE and BRE students must complete a paper application available at [BreckenridgeRecreation.com](http://BreckenridgeRecreation.com) or at the front desk of Breck Rec Center.

Enrollment into the After School CATCH program is only confirmed via the online registration. Participants must register to attend programming a minimum of 3 days per week. The only exception to this is if the program is at capacity on some days that a child wishes to attend. At this point we would allow a child to be enrolled 1 or 2 days/week to accommodate as many families as possible. Registrations are accepted on a first come first served basis and wait list options available if capacity is reached. Once a space becomes available, you will be notified via email that your child is enrolled. Each program location has a cap of 30 program participants per day.

**You MUST register for each session you are interested in your child being enrolled in separately.**

Enrollment in 1 session of CATCH does not guarantee your child a spot in the following sessions. Application release dates are as follows.

Program registrations are handled on a first come first served basis. If program is at capacity, a wait list registration is available. The wait list is also handled on a first come first served basis.

Students who attend DVE, FRE, SCE, or SVE will be informed upon registration by Keystone Science School’s Active Registration system if their child has been enrolled into the program, or is on the wait list for all or some desired days. Students who attend UBE or BRE will be notified by Breckenridge Rec Center Youth Program Coordinator if they are accepted into the After School CATCH Program.



### Confirmed Registrations

All participants who do not qualify for a free After School CATCH Program pay a 20% deposit upon registering and the remaining balance in full by the 15<sup>th</sup> day in the session. If this is not a possibility for a family, we ask that you contact us at [Support@KeystoneScienceSchool.org](mailto:Support@KeystoneScienceSchool.org) to set up a payment plan.

Breckenridge Recreation Center will e-mail an invoice upon your child's acceptance into the After School CATCH program. Upon receiving an invoice applicants who are CHP+ members must provide a \$50 non-refundable deposit, and full paying applicants must provide a non-refundable deposit of \$100 before the first day of each new session. The remainder of the balance for program participation is due no later than 15<sup>th</sup> day of programming for each 12-week session.

Keystone Science School and Breckenridge Recreation Center **will not offer any refunds** to parents or guardians for cancellation from the After School CATCH Program. If a participant cancels from a session or reduces the number of days they attend programming they must first contact Keystone Science School's Customer Experience Team or Breckenridge Recreation Center Youth Program Coordinator. Beginning on the day of parent notification the unused registration fees can be transferred for that child's registration fees later in the same school year. No money shall be rolled over from one school year to another. Full paying or CHP+ program participants that are enrolled in 5 or 4 days and who request to drop to 4 or 3 days per week can transfer the difference in program fees to be utilized during After School CATCH Programs within the same designated school year.

### Program Participant Policy

The After School CATCH Program has a **4-strike policy** to correct negative or harmful behavior. Instructors will notify parents or guardians about behavior issues with their child. **STRIKE 1** is a written warning, **STRIKE 2** will result in a behavior contract between the child, instructor and parents/guardians, **STRIKE 3** will result in a 3-day suspension from the After School CATCH Program, and **STRIKE 4** will result in expulsion from the After School CATCH Program for the remainder of the session. Instructors will notify the School-Based Programs Manager of the strikes and will work collaboratively with families to ensure all children receive beneficial and safe programming. Severe and/or persistently disruptive or unsafe behavior can result in immediate suspension or expulsion from the program at the discretion of the School-Based Programs Manager.

A **late pick-up policy** is also in place in order to respect the program and program instructors. A 5-minute grace period will be granted. Any child who is not picked up within 5 minutes of the program's flexible pick-up time of 5:30pm (or 6pm for the program held at Breck rec Center) will be given a strike. The first **STRIKE** is a warning, **STRIKE 2** will result in a 2-day suspension from the After School CATCH Program, and **STRIKE 3** will result in expulsion for the remainder of the session.
