



Although the days in Colorado are typically sunny and warm, the weather can change rapidly. Frequent afternoon thunderstorms and snow storms make good rain gear and warm clothes a must.

Your student should wear comfortable, well-used clothing appropriate for hiking and playing outdoors in all weather conditions. Synthetic gear like poly, nylon, or wool is recommended over cotton for outdoor activities. **Expect your student to have fun and get dirty!**

CLOTHING

Come to your program wearing comfy clothes that are appropriate for the day's weather and activities.

- ❑ Snow coat
- ❑ Snow pants
- ❑ 1-2 warm layers under snow clothes
- ❑ Additional warm layer in backpack

HEADS, HANDS, AND FEET

- ❑ Snow Boots
- ❑ Waterproof gloves
- ❑ Winter/warm socks
- ❑ Extra winter/warm socks in backpack

GEAR

- ❑ Day Pack or school backpack (Without school items in it)
- ❑ 2 Water bottles (filled before pick up)
- ❑ Sunscreen SPF 15 or higher
- ❑ Lip Balm (SPF preferred)
- ❑ Sunglasses
- ❑ Pencil or Pen
- ❑ Lunch
- ❑ Snacks

NOTE: We don't provide lunch so the students will all need to have their lunch with them in their backpacks for eating on the trail or at KSS.
